Introduction

Enigma Wheel 8 is a puzzle composed of 8 blocks numbered one through eight or numbered one through four and are color-coded for the wheel on which they originate. In starting positions, there is an empty center surrounded by eight squares in a cross fashion: above the empty center are two number squares and also left, right and below it. The blocks on the outer ring can be rotated clockwise or counter clockwise. As long as there is an empty space, blocks can be moved there. The object of the puzzle is similar to that of a popular puzzle known as "15;" arrange the squares into a given pattern. However, the rotated exterior wheel, and movement limitations with the empty square.

Representation

When representing a wheel without the use of a picture, the four squares on the exterior wheel at the default position are numbered one through four and the interior four are numbered five through eight clockwise.
